Herman Maril at Cahoon Museum

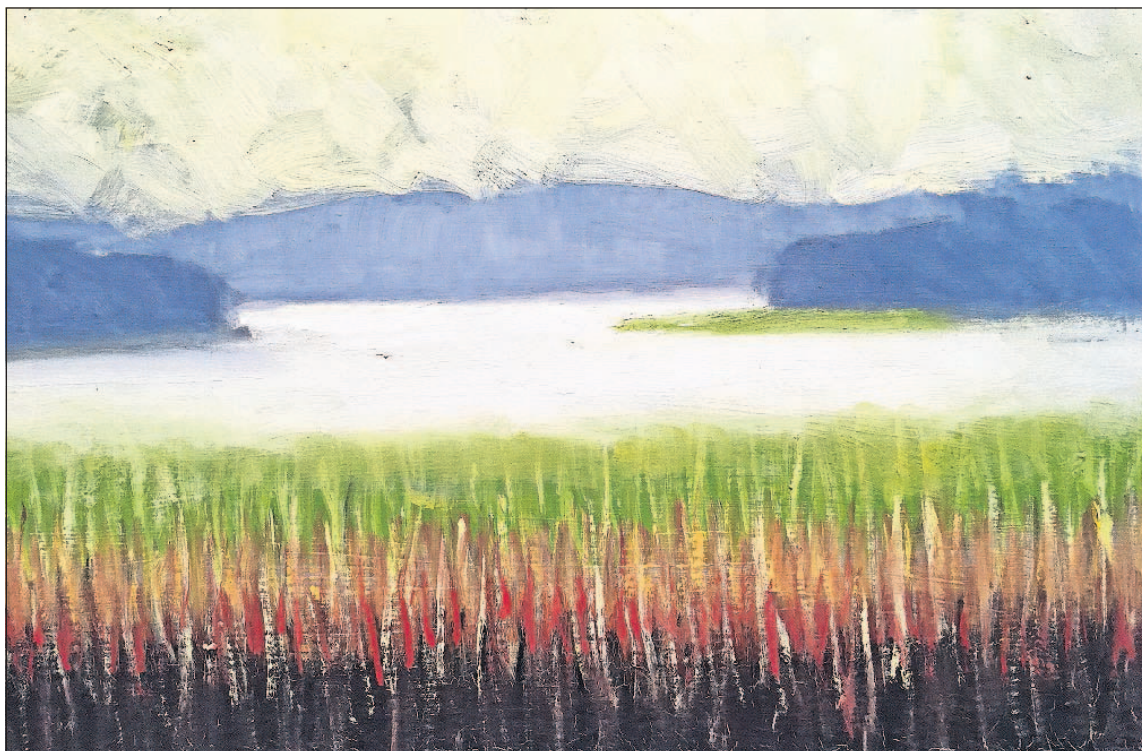
A major exhibit of paintings, watercolors, drawings and prints by Herman Maril, Provincetown modernist — nearly 90 artworks in all — at the Cahoon Museum of American Art in Cotuit, will have an opening reception at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, Aug. 18, at 4676 Falmouth Road. The exhibit, "Herman Maril: The Strong Forms of Our Experience," will be on view through Oct. 28. Admission is free for the opening reception, and Ann Prentice Wagner, curator of drawings at the Arkansas Art Center (and curator of the exhibit), and the artist's son, David Maril, will be there for a discussion.

A scholar's panel and discussion, led by Christine McCarthy, executive director of Provincetown Art Association and Museum, will be held at 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 16, at the museum. The panel discussion is free with museum admission.

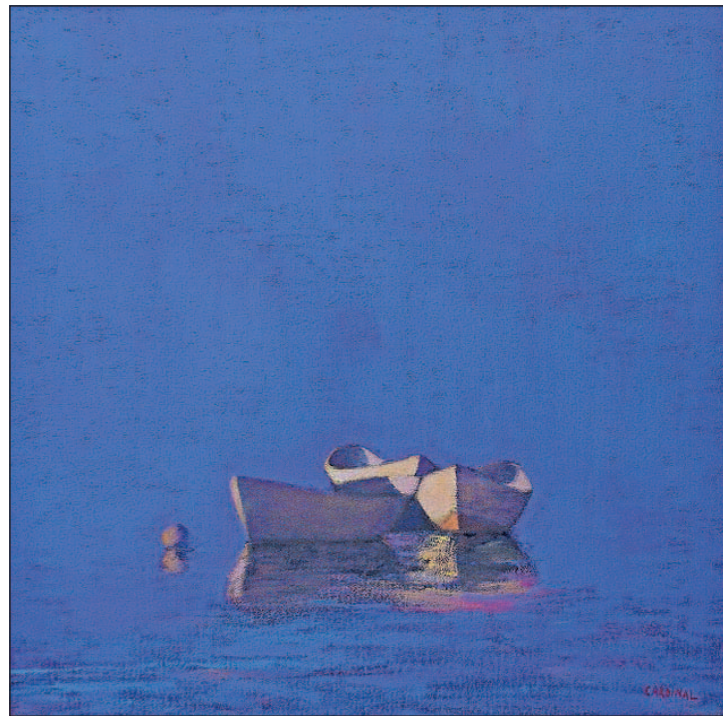


"Hurricane," by Herman Maril, is part of a retrospective exhibit of Maril's work at the Cahoon Museum.
