Cahoon Museum Presents Series of Summer Gallery Talks

[Cotuit, MA] The [Cahoon Museum of American Art](#) announces its summer series of *Gallery Talks* with Michael MacMahon. MacMahon, the Museum's education and programs manager, will speak in-depth about the Museum's two dynamic new exhibits ([Ethan Murrow: The Greenhouse](#) and [Duncan Johnson: Under Construction](#)), the popular [Blue Trees installation](#), the art and lives of [Ralph and Martha Cahoon](#), and the historic Crocker House. The programs will take place in the Cahoon Museum at 1 pm on Wednesdays from July 14 through August 11. The *Gallery Talks* are free with admission.

This is a unique opportunity to engage directly with the art, to learn more about the artist, his materials and artistic process, and to better understand the message behind this important installation. The tour will be led by Cahoon Museum education and programs manager Michael MacMahon.
