

Exhibition Proposals

Thank you for your interest in exhibiting at the Cahoon Museum of American Art.

The Cahoon Museum creates and presents continually changing exhibitions on themes that relate to the Museum's collection of American art and contemporary art practices.

The Museum engages the community through compelling exhibitions and related educational programming such as talks and lectures, group tours, classes, workshops, and special programs.

The Cahoon Museum welcomes exhibition proposals from artists, guest curators, or institutions.

Proposal Guidelines:

- Each submission must include the following:
 - 1. A one-page description of the exhibition.
 - 2. A checklist of art that will be on display; include information such as artist name, title, media, and size for each piece
 - 3. Artist or Curator biography with contact information including an email address, phone number, and mailing address.
 - 4. 5-10 digital images of proposed artwork.
 - 5. Description of a target audience, examples of at least two programs (i.e. talks, workshops, etc.) to take place in concurrence with the exhibit, and information which may be of interest for school or tour groups.
 - 6. Any catalogs, press, or other support materials
 - 7. SASE for return of application materials

Review Process:

- The Museum's Collections and Exhibitions Committee meets periodically to review proposals and select exhibitions.
- The Museum books its exhibitions 1-3 years in advance.
